Under-represented Minority and Disadvantaged Student Scholarship

- The Indiana Architectural Foundation (IAF) / American Architectural Foundation (AAF) Under-represented Minority and Disadvantaged Student Scholarship will be awarded to one or more undergraduate or graduate under-represented minority or disadvantaged students of the Department of Architecture in the College of Architecture and Planning this fall. There can be one award in the full amount of \$4,000 and as many as 4 awards of \$1,000 each. The awards must be used for tuition only.
- **Requirements:** The IAF / AAF Scholarship shall be awarded for a combination of demonstrated financial need, demonstrated leadership, or solid academic performance (above 3.0) to under-represented minority or disadvantaged students as defined by Ball State University. The award can be used for tuition for on-campus or off-campus programs that are given for credit at Ball State University.
- The student recipients are required to submit a copy of the cancelled check showing that the funds were used for tuition only to the Indiana Architectural Foundation Board through its member on the CAP faculty and/or administration.
- **Application requirements:** (1) A letter written by the applicant addressing the basis of the award. (2) A transcript of grades and (3) the names of two Ball State CAP faculty or practicing architect nominators
- **Selection Process:** Using the submitted application materials, Architecture Department leadership shall choose the most appropriate method to assure that most deserving candidates for the scholarship are identified and awarded.
- **Deadline:** September 25, 2008 12:00 noon in the Architecture Department office with Julie Kratzner. No late submissions will be considered.
